Objective #1: Each year of the five-year
plan, the Council will provide support to

strengthen a statewide self-advocacy organization by increasing activity and participation by self-advocates in Arkansas.

Key Activities:

- 1.The Council will provide funding to strengthen a statewide advocacy organization by facilitating and funding ways to allow an organization to increase membership and participation of self-advocates in that group.
- 2.The Council will provide for consultation, support, and assistance to self-advocacy organizations to increase leadership and participation in self-advocacy

Expected Outputs:

- 1.1 funded project, 1 self-advocacy awareness campaign, 50 self- advocate participants; and increase membership in organization by 50%
- 2.1 organization supported, 1 leadership/train-the-trainer class for organization officers; develop a Self-advocate leadership training curriculum.

Expected Objective Outcomes:

- 1.Increased awareness about self-advocacy in Arkansas; Increased number of individuals employing self-advocacy skills in their daily lives; Increased activity and participation by self-advocates; a strengthened and expanded statewide self-advocacy organization with improved leadership and organizational skills

Key Activities:

1. The Council will provide funding and resources in collaboration with the developmental disabilities network to continue employment of a statewide self-advocate coordinator, who is a self-advocate, to support self-advocates and families.

1.1 funded statewide coordinator

Increased policy meeting participation; improved collaboration in state-wide self-advocacy; increased support for self-advocates; increased support for families of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities; creation of a self-advocacy toolkit

Objective #3: Each year of the five-year plan, the Council will increase opportunities for self-advocates who are leaders to train other self-advocates to become leaders and increase opportunities for participation in cross-disability, culturally diverse organizations

Key Activities:

1. The Council will collaborate with Disability Rights Arkansas and Partners for Inclusive Communities to increase self-advocacy by

providing funding, technical assistance and administrative support in a continuing annual self-advocacy leadership training event.

2.The Council will provide funding and support for self-advocates to participate in cross-disability, culturally diverse events or activities.

3.The Council will provide funding and support that enables those self-advocates who completed leadership training to provide training, in their own communities, to other self-advocates who then may also become leaders

Expected Outputs:

1.1 self-advocacy leadership training event; 25 leadership training participants

2.3 self-advocates funded participation in a cross-disability event or activity

3.2 self-advocacy leaders funded to provide training to other self-advocates in their communities

Expected Objective Outcomes:

1.Increased leadership knowledge/skills for training participants; increased number of self-advocates engaging in leadership activities and roles; Increased participation of self-advocates in Arkansas in a cross-disability event or activity; increased support for culturally diverse organizations in Arkansas serving individuals with developmental disabilities and their families; Increased number of trained self-advocate leaders in Arkansas
